"Schools weren't integrated back then, and my parents wanted to give me the best possible education, so coming to live with my uncle in Houston was the best option for me," shares Ms. Jean.

Long after her high school days, her children asked her to come back to Houston, where they both now reside.

"I was living in Marshall by myself, and both my son and daughter asked me to move to Houston so that I could be closer to them. They both wanted me to live with them, but I didn't want to interfere with their lives so St. Dominic Village was my best choice," she tells us.

About a month after she moved into independent living, she wrote her friends back in Marshall a letter saying that she didn't have any complaints about her new home. Shortly afterwards, four couples from Marshall came to visit Ms. Jean because they just had to see St. Dominic Village for themselves.

"They said that I made St. Dominic Village sound like it was heaven, and they wanted to see what angels looked like," she laughs.

On most evenings Ms. Jean can be found sitting outside of Charlotte Hall, chatting with her close friend, Ms. Althea. "I love it!" she exclaims.

"I have found some good friends and enjoy the beautiful scenery. The activity director is wonderful and is always trying to please us. The other residents here are wonderful. The staff is wonderful. I feel very safe here."

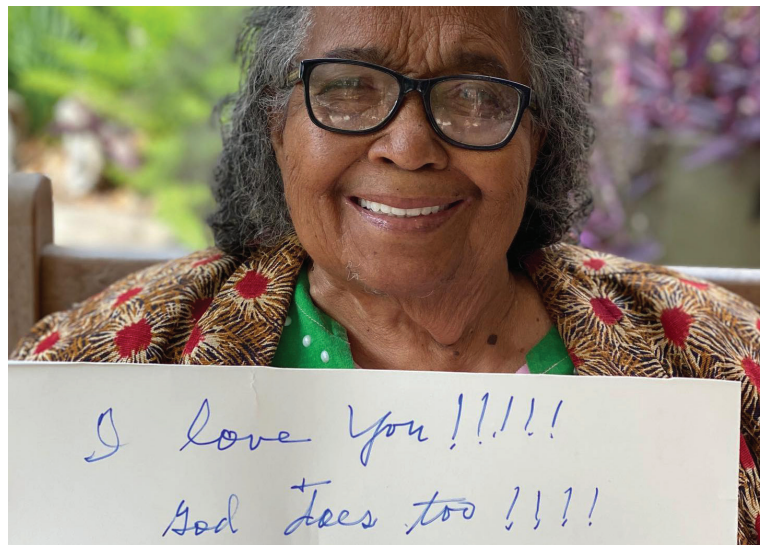
When asked what advice she would give to anyone who is considering St. Dominic Village as their home she simply asks, "Do you want a nice place to come home? A nice community where you can live among others?"

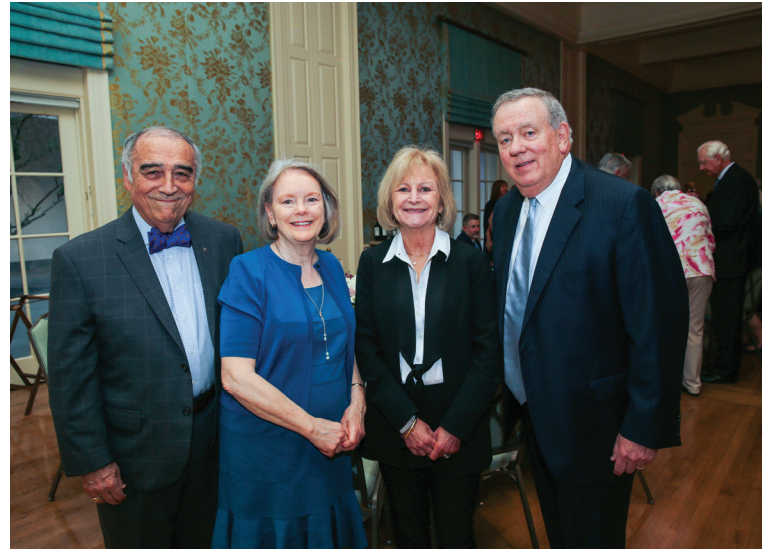

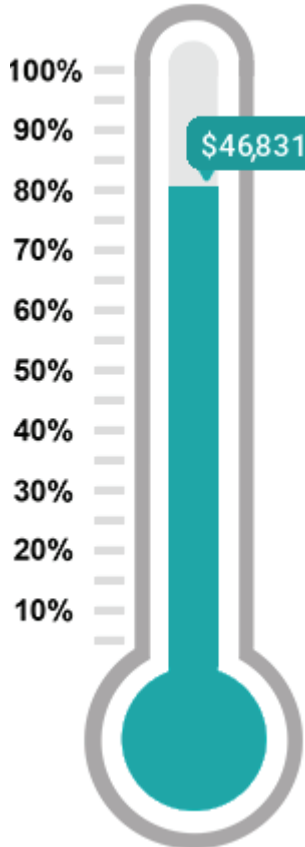
