Sacrament of Penance & Reconciliation

or by appointment with the Priest. Communal Penance Services are scheduled during lent and Advent. According to the Church's command, "after having attained the age of discretion each of the faithful is bound by an obligation faithfully to confess serious sins at least once a year."

(Catechism of the Catholic Church. Paragraph 1457.)

Sacrament of Baptism

Because the Church requires preparation for all Sacraments, baptismal classes (seminars) are held on a periodic basis. Contact the pastor to discuss the baptism of your infant children and make arrangements to attend the next seminar. Seminar dates are published in the bulletin. Baptism of older children and adults are coordinated through the parish program of religious formation. Contact the Church Office for more information.

Sacrament of Marriage

There is a six-month preparation program required by the Church. Please contact the Church Office as soon as you are engaged and prior to setting any date for a marriage. Freedom to marry must be determined before dates can be established for the Sacrament of Marriage.

Is Jesus important enough for you to set aside one half-hour once a month? That is all He is asking. In everything you do, put God first and He will direct you and crown your efforts with success. Eucharistic Adoration is held every "First Friday" from 8:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. (Benediction).

Funerals

Arrangements are made with the pastor, at the convenience of the family, when a loved one has passed from this life unto the Eternity of our God. If a loved one is dying, please contact the pastor as soon as possible so that the Rites of the Church may be celebrated with your loved one prior to their passing.

Visitation of the Sick and Elderly

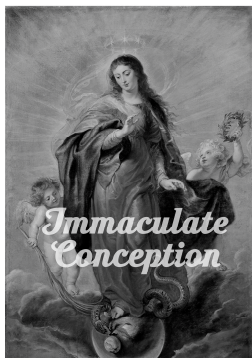

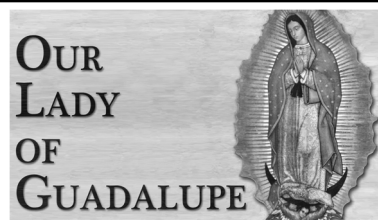

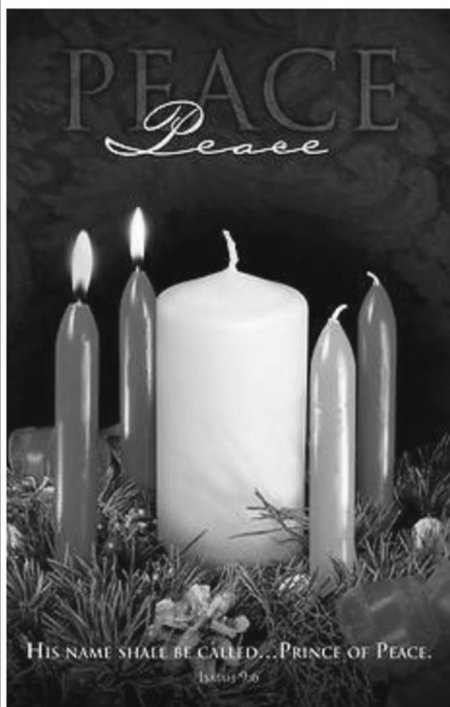
