

**Sts. Peter & Paul Building and Grounds Committee Update  
December 2025**

In June 2025 a Building and Grounds Committee was formed to ensure our facilities and campus are maintained properly. Below is a brief overview of what we have accomplished and future plans. **Completed Projects:**

Multiple projects have been completed in 2025 including painting problem areas on the interior and exterior of the Sanctuary, repainting entire Ross Hall Gymnasium, new lighting at Ross Hall, removal/trimming of large trees around the Rectory, and numerous other minor repairs in all buildings.

**Significant Future Projects:**

- Repair problem areas on roof of Sanctuary
- Repair/Replace blacktop parking lot
- Repair/Replace Steeples

Replace Annex building - The interior and exterior of the Annex has been in very poor condition for many years. This building is used often by several adult Church groups, Religious Education for Youth, rented for Private events for Parishioners and Non-Parishioners, etc. The committee has discussed the possibility of adding a new building to be used for the same purposes and eventually demolish the Annex. Preliminary plans for the new building would include a large gathering hall (approx. 2000 square feet), small kitchen, and 6 classrooms/meeting rooms that accommodate up to 30 people each. The building could be located directly east of the Parish Hall where the Convent formerly stood and below is a rendering of what the exterior could look like.

**Sacrament of Penance & Reconciliation**

**Saturday 4:00 – 4:30 p.m. before the 5:00 pm Mass or by appointment with the Priest. Communal Penance Services are scheduled during lent and Advent. According to the Church's command, "after having attained the age of discretion each of the faithful is bound by an obligation faithfully to confess serious sins at least once a year." (Catechism of the Catholic Church. Paragraph 1457.)**

**Sacrament of Baptism**

**Because the Church requires preparation for all Sacraments, baptismal classes (seminars) are held on a periodic basis. Contact the pastor to discuss the baptism of your infant children and make arrangements to attend the next seminar. Seminar dates are published in the bulletin. Baptism of older children and adults are coordinated through the parish program of religious formation. Contact the Church Office for more information.**

**Sacrament of Marriage**

**If you are planning for the sacrament of matrimony, please notify the Parish Office (Pastor) one year in advance. There is a six-month preparation program required by the Church. Please contact the Church Office as soon as you are engaged and prior to setting any date for a marriage. Freedom to marry must be determined before dates can be established for the Sacrament of Marriage.**


