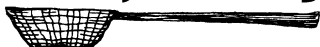

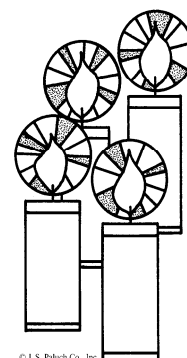

FROM THE RESPECT LIFE MINISTRY**UPCOMING PRO-LIFE EVENTS****LEGALIZING PHYSICIAN-ASSISTED SUICIDE (PAS) IN MASSACHUSETTS**

The Joint Committee on Public Health has scheduled a public hearing of the "END OF LIFE OPTIONS ACT" (S.1208 and H.1926) which would legalize Physician-Assisted Suicide (PAS) in Massachusetts.

What is Physician-Assisted Suicide?

Physician-Assisted Suicide is deliberately and intentionally providing an individual with a lethal drug to commit suicide.

Quote from Bishop Robert McManus:

"As Catholics, we should be in the forefront of working for a society where the right to life is inviolable. A vote for physician-assisted suicide is a failure to foster and promote the compassionate care we should promise for the terminally ill. Our moral responsibility is to surround our terminally ill loved ones with genuine concern and love so that they will not be driven to the desperate point of considering suicide."
