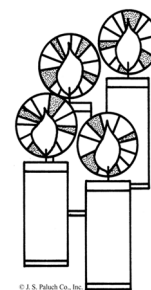

Flocknote message sent out September 16th:

Dear Member of the Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish Family,

Attached is a synopsis of the Strategic Initiative so that, as has been the case throughout the last five years, you will know how your money has been spent. Technically, the initiative continues because there are still a couple individuals making their final pledge payments and there is still a campaign funded enhancement project underway. That project is the conversion of the heating system at the Emmaus Parish Center from an oil fired to a gas fired system. It has been delayed because of the effect of the Corona Virus on the timetable National Grid is operating with, in running the necessary gas line to our ministry building.

As you may recall, at the start of the campaign we identified key objectives based on the greatest needs of the parish. Then, as donations were received we systematically went about completing the repair and enhancement projects. As you can plainly see the initiative has been a great success. The necessary repair projects that were completed, which realistically would have been extremely difficult to fund by other means, are nothing short of remarkable.

In addition, a central goal of the campaign to move the parish out of debt was met and throughout the five years it allowed us to cover major yearly operational shortfalls in an effort to keep the parish debt free. Without the initiative we could easily have found ourselves at this point in total debt to the diocese of over \$150,000. Unfortunately as offertory has substantially fallen year after year, we are continually forced to deficit spend in order to pay for such things as utilities and supplies. As a consequence we will end this fiscal year in debt.

However, the huge success of this multi-year initiative is a credit to the parish and to the two coordinators of the capital campaign, Don Vallee and Nancy Kudzal. The time volunteered by these two individuals over the course of the last six years is staggering. When the opportunity presents itself please offer a word of thanks to Don and Nancy for their service to you and the parish. Congratulations, well done, and Happy Anniversary Sacred Heart!

Footnotes

1. A de-icing system was required to address dangerous ice buildup in the gutters of the GYM and at Front door of Hall. Falling ice damaged a car and was putting people at risk.
2. A donor gave to the campaign specifically to address the new church sign. This item was not on the stated Capital Campaign objectives.
