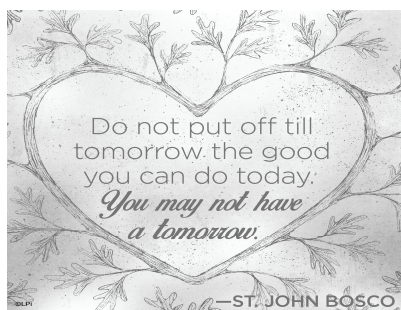

PARTNERS IN CHARITY APPEAL

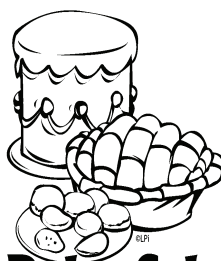
