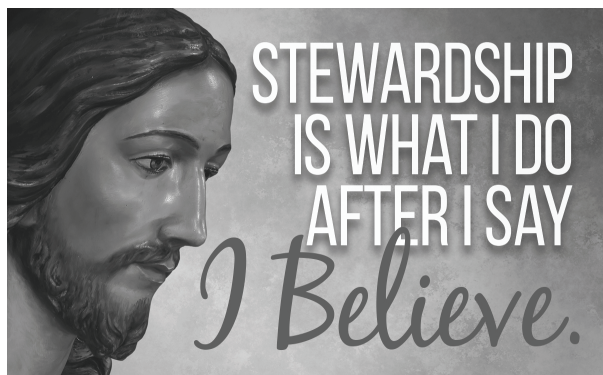
Last weekend's collection was \$2,006
