Christ Comes to You

As I write this, I have just come from a meeting of people who visit those confined to their homes or to care facilities throughout Holland, Douglas, and Fennville. A very fine partnership has developed among the Holland parishes of Our Lady of the Lake and St. Francis deSales, along with St. Peter parish in Douglas. Soon, San Felipe de Jesus will launch a similar ministry. This partnership is unique in that it not only spans parish limits but crosses a diocesan

boundary as well.

While the usual purpose of what you find in this space is to be instructional in some way, today I'm resorting to a blatant advertisement and appeal. Your kind indulgence is requested!

The Holland parishes provide ministers to visit virtually all of the care facilities north of Lake Macatawa, and ministers from St. Francis attend to facilities on the "south side." St. Peter parish is responsible for the Resthaven facility on 40th Street, Douglas Cove in our own neighborhood, and Golden Orchards in Fennville. In addition, we provide service to the Appledorn South and Appledorn North skilled care facilities, even though these are just north of the diocesan boundary (32nd St.). In the future, we will add Addington Place, also on 40th Street.

Besides these facilities, we have several parishioners who visit individuals confined to their own homes but not living in a care facility. And there are several who take the Eucharist to spouses or other loved ones in their own home on either a temporary or long-term basis.

Each of these ministers acts in response to the Baptismal call to serve others in ways that are uniquely suited to each person. No one is called to do everything, but everyone is called to do something to bring Christ to others — in this case quite literally bringing Christ in the Eucharist to someone who would otherwise be without this precious sacramental experience.

For those who have responded to the call to this ministry (a call to ministry is also known as a "vocation!") these visits, usually weekly, are moments of peaceful contact with a very appreciative fellow parishioner who treasures the visit and the Eucharist that comes with it.

You have heard me say, and I hope you have heard others say, that the Eucharist is not simply something we "get." It is something we do! It is an action, including worship, sharing the meal, and going out to bring Christ more fully into the world.

God's desire to be joined with us begins with the Incarnation — the Word becoming flesh and dwelling among us — and continues with the Eucharist, given in the Last Supper along with the instruction "Do this in remembrance of me." Our liturgical worship is meant to continue long after we leave the Mass itself.

I ask that you consider whether you are called to this ministry. The task is not difficult, and its rewards are far greater than the effort required. With a sufficient number of such ministers, travel or other breaks would pose lit-

tle difficulty as there could be teams of folks who cover each others' vacations, cruises, out of town baptisms and weddings, and who knows what else. With a sufficient number, no one would be overextended or ever feel confined by this commitment to serve others in such a personal, beautiful way.

Kindly pray, think, consider, ponder, ruminate, meditate, and *listen* for God's voice speaking to you. Not everyone will hear this call; not everyone needs to do this. But it's quite likely that God has provided our parish with more than enough people to serve the needs of those who will otherwise go too long without the Eucharist.
