Each session will define the topic and opportunities for participation.

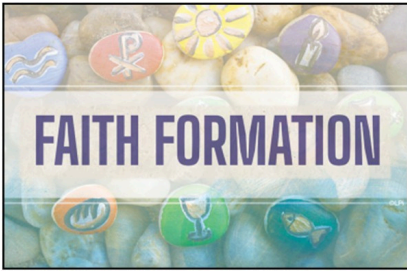
Pizza will be served at the conclusion, around 6:30, along with time for questions & answers.

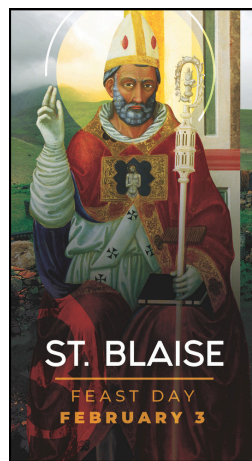

Last Sunday, the 1st Reconciliation students, along with their parents, discovered different ways Jesus Heals.



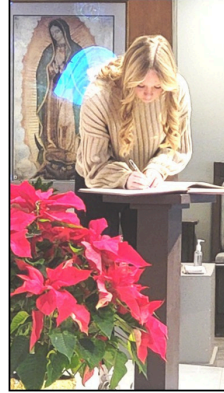
Candles will be available for purchase in the Gathering Space the weekends before and after February 2.

The Future is Now

On the publication date of this bulletin, some 80+ teens in grades 7-12 will be at the 10:30 Mass for the beginning of their “NET” (National Evangelization Teams) retreat. It’s a one-day gathering of teens from all three parishes in our collaborative: St. Peter, San Felipe de Jesús, and St. Basil.

First, a warm welcome to each and every one of the teens who will gather at St. Peter’s for this life-changing experience. Teens, please take a few moments to consider these thoughts from a “boomer” who cares very much that you know how important you are to the Church and to the world. And I’m not alone here; I speak for hundreds of Boomers, GenXers, Millennials, and maybe even GenZ (but you already know them; they’re your parents!)

We “boomers” are known for a couple of things. First, we have no concept of how old we are. We think we are still 18, or 25, or 36, or whatever was a good year for us. We are often late to retire, and even when we do, we like to keep busy. Sometimes, it seems as if we never get out of the way and make room for younger people to step in. But we are united in our concern for the future of the Church and for the young people who, it sometimes seems, are not drawn to participate in the Church as many of us were.

We often hear that “young people are the future of the Church.” True, I suppose, but this could mean, “young people, stand back and wait your turn.” That would be a big mistake!

As a young person, you are the PRESENT of the Church. You are here now, and it matters. YOU matter. The Church is called “Catholic” for a reason: Catholic means “universal.” It means there is a place for everyone. There is a place for you, now, as well as in the future.

What would finding your place in the Church do for you? There’s a lot. First, learning to follow Jesus gives a clear sense of direction when the rest of life seems pretty scattered and complex. Catholic faith is interesting, if you allow yourself to really learn it. It’s intelligent. It takes questions, even challenging questions, gracefully. And it helps to provide a good sense of the purpose of your life.

There are two things, especially, that our Catholic faith can help teens to do. First, learning Catholic morality helps you to learn to make good decisions. Making good decisions is the key to earning trust from parents, other adults, and even from your peers. A person who has a framework for making sound decisions that lead to good outcomes is a person that others look up to and respect.

Second, becoming familiar with the teaching of Jesus and of the Church that He founded on this earth can help you to find a direction for your life. How many times does some adult ask you “where are you going to go to college?” or “what do you want to do when you grow up?” (The question morphs as you get older...) Living a Catholic life doesn’t necessarily give direct answers to these questions, but it does build self-confidence and the sense that there are possibilities and a path for your life that you will surely discover as you grow.

And what can you do for the Church? That is, how can you serve the Church? (another way to gain skills, experience, and confidence that will serve you well throughout your life)

Once you are confirmed, all the ministries in the Church are open to you: Lector, Extraordinary Minister of Communion, senior altar server, catechist assistant, musician, usher/greeter, and more. And prior to Confirmation, the ministry of altar server is open to you.

Besides the visible public roles, which are not for everyone — some don’t feel comfortable in a public role — there are lots of ways to serve others in the name of the Church.

The main thing you can do for the Church, and the thing that allows the Church to do its best for you, is to show up! Participate at Mass each week. Get familiar with it; get to know people, listen to the message of the readings and the homily, and even the messages in the music. Be alert and find your place, whether it’s in a public function of some kind or simply being a part of the assembly of the Body of Christ.

You may be the future, but you are also the present! You’re here now. Don’t stand back; take your place here and now. Welcome! And may your retreat be filled with joy, hope, and abundant blessings!
