

In light of continuing advances in technology, the Vatican media has issued a warning about videos that combine images of the Pope with a voice almost identical to his own, creating speeches he has never made through the use of AI. This type of artificial content creation is called "morphing", and unfortunately, has existed for some time. It's important to remember that if you do not see a reputable source attributed to content associated with Pope Leo XIV on social media, all of His official speeches, addresses, and texts can be found in their entirety at vatican.va.
