#### St. Charles Borromeo Parish School of Religion

Confirmation Registration: If you are a registered, regularly attending family of St. Charles parish and have a child (ren) entering the 8th-11th grade who desires the Sacrament of Confirmation, please pick up a registration packet in church lobby. Classes for this 2 year program will begin in September and meet a minimum of 2 Sunday mornings/evenings a month. You must register yearly to be enrolled in this program.

First Holy Communion Registration:

If you are a registered, regularly attending family of St. Charles parish and have a child(ren) entering the 1st grade (or older children in need of this Sacrament), pick up a registration packet in church lobby. Classes for this 2 year program will begin in September and meet a minimum of 2 Sunday mornings a month, with athome family lessons as well. You must register yearly to be enrolled in this program.

#### Catechesis of the Good Shepherd:

Parishioners with child(ren) ages 3-12 are invited to register their chid(ren) for Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Atrium, a Montessori-based form of catechesis grounded in the Church's liturgy and doctrine. Scripture passages and themes presented throughout the year range from the Good Shepherd and Eucharistic Presence to Jesus' infancy and the liturgical year.

If your child has completed First Holy Communion and Reconciliation, they are required to continue faith formation with the Atrium if the Sacrament of Confirmation is desired in the future.
