2 Timothy 1:6-8, 13-14 Although the author attributed the second letter to Timothy to St. Paul, it was probably written by someone else as much as 30 years after Paul's death. This was

an acceptable practice at the time. One important theme of this letter is the need to be faithful to the Gospel and not to be swayed by false teachings.


#### Parish News & Announcements:




