

### **IMPORTANT REMINDERS TO PARENTS**

"Passport To Heaven" - Students are required to bring their special passport to Class & Mass for Attendance. At the end of each Weekend Masses, there will be a minister tasked to stamp their passports.

Attendance (Class / Mass) - Regular attendance is a must. Failure to fulfill this required obligation could potentially delay your child's reception of his/her Sacrament. If your child is unable to attend either Sunday Class or Mass, notify the teacher or Maribel. Each Student is only allowed a total of 4 unexcused absences.

### How to Make Up for Excused/Unexcused Absences

1<sup>st</sup> absence (either Sunday Class or Mass) would be 1 hour of volunteer work; 2<sup>nd</sup> time = 2 hours; 3<sup>rd</sup> time = 3 hours,... so on.

If your child has missed more than two classes or Masses please contact Maribel to see what your options are of making up the missed classes or Masses.







# Bulletin Announcements - October 9, 16, 23, and 30, and November 6

### VOTE "NO" ON PROPOSITION 1

Proposition 1 is a worst-case scenario for abortion in California. It is an expensive and misleading ballot measure that allows unlimited late-term abortions — for any reason, at any time, even moments before birth, paid for by tax dollars.

Prop 1 isn't needed. Sadly, California already has some of the most permissive abortion laws in the nation that would remain in effect without the amendment, including our current limit on late-term abortions that are permitted only for the life and health of the mother. Prop 1 destroys this common-sense limit.


