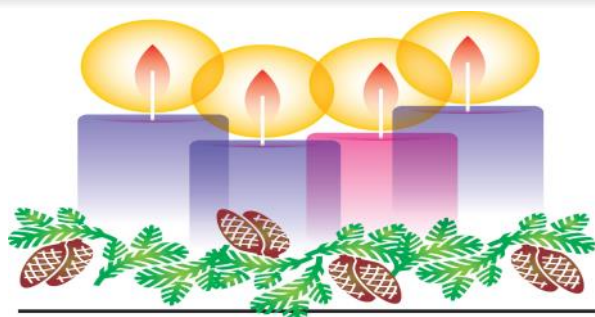

Las Posadas commemorates the journey that Joseph and Mary made from Nazareth to Bethlehem in search of a safe refuge where Mary could give birth to the baby Jesus.

The 9 days of celebration represents the 9 months of pregnancy of the Virgin Mary with her son Jesus.

What gifts are given on Las Posadas? Drinks, food, and a star shaped pinata define this evening fiesta. As the night draws to an end, aguinaldos (small bags filled with treats and candies) are distributed as parting gifts to the guests to help them continue on their "journey".

### Advent IV — The Look of Love

**An unknown author once said, “Blood makes you related but *loyalty* makes you *family*”.**

*If someone is not related to us by blood, what kind of loyalty is required for us to call and consider this person a family?*

*Loyalty is a strong feeling of allegiance or faithfulness given to someone. In an ideal world, loyalty should come from a genuine place of trust, respect, and ultimately love. Not all forms of loyalty, however, are founded on trust, respect, love and not even rooted from a genuine desire to be loyal. Sadly, there are those whose loyalty is based on necessity, a requirement, a deal, or even fear or duress (force or violence). For instance, a debtor giving a very business-induced amount of loyalty to his/her creditor until the account has been settled. Similarly, parents of an infant giving a very cautious amount of loyalty to their child's pediatrician before the child turns into teen or an adult. Also, a fourth grade student giving his/her obedient loyalty to his/her fourth grade teacher and not his/her former third grade teacher. Perhaps these examples are very limited and imperfect, but one point is clear -for us to truly appreciate it and claim that “...loyalty makes you family,” we have to clarify what loyalty genuinely means for us as Catholics.*

Today's Gospel Reading (Matt 1:18-24) tells us about the event when the angel appeared to a Virgin, named Mary chosen to become the Mother of God's Son. The strange part about this story is that Mary has never been married nor has she been with a man. For her to be pregnant in her pure state shatters the Laws of Logic and defies the Rules of Science.

No wonder why, Joseph, the man who was engaged to her had real trouble understanding this mystery. He did not even want to be with Mary because it was a disgrace and something unacceptable during their time. Thus, Joseph decided to leave Mary quietly. It presented us that Joseph was at first unwilling to acknowledge Jesus as his son. **Why was Joseph unwilling?** Experts are divided.

- \* The **traditional answer** is that Joseph suspected Mary of having committed an adultery (in Jewish law an “engagement to be married” had the same legal force as a “marriage”) and wanted to obey the law prescribing separation from an adulteress wife.
- \* **Another explanation** is that Joseph was convinced of Mary's innocence but felt he had to obey the law and divorce her.
- \* A **third explanation** – (the most widely accepted at the present time) is that Joseph was told by Mary of the virginal conception and, in a spirit of religious awe, decided to draw back, not wanting to step in uninvited into God's plan of salvation.

**Why did Joseph eventually accept his mission and be with Mary?** It was because of Joseph's loyalty to our God and His Will. His loyalty is founded on the Love he has for Mary and the future salvation of all. We can only imagine that Joseph's decision to follow God was also moved by the **Look of Love** found in the eyes of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Love is the only criterion to genuinely profess one's loyalty to someone. Without love, genuine loyalty would not exist. Joseph may not be the biological/blood father of Jesus but his genuine loyalty founded on love made his part of the Holy Family.

Please go home with a heart filled with God's love today for you. May your family, friends, and neighbors see the Look of Love in you in Christ!
