- Minimum of two (2) years of experience as a volleyball coach

- Valid Illinois Teaching Certificate

This position reports directly to the High School Athletic Director and is considered a professional head coaching role. All duties must be conducted in accordance with the policies, rules, and regulations of the Illinois High School Association (IHSA), St. Teresa High School, and the Diocese of Springfield.

- Assesses student-athlete skills and assigns team positions
- Develops and implements structured practice schedules
- Supervises assistant coaches
- Develops game strategies and evaluates performance
- Monitors academic eligibility and promotes academic success
- Models sportsmanship and Catholic values
- Oversees equipment, uniforms, and supplies
- Adheres to the St. Teresa Coaches Handbook and IHSA regulations
