My dear parishioners:

Over the last two weekends (two weekends ago in English and last weekend in Spanish) I read at Masses the letter written by Bishop Guillory concerning the issue of the sexual abuse of minors and vulnerable adults committed by clergy (deacons, priests and bishops). In his letter, Bishop Guillory reminded us of the need to pray fervently for all victims of sexual abuse that they may find healing and peace. He also assured us that the Diocese of Beaumont takes very seriously its responsibility to provide a safe and holy environment for all parishioners, but especially our children.

As your pastor, I want to assure you that this same vigilance is a priority at the level of the parish. Over the years pastors and parishioners of Our Lady of the Pines Church have done a very good job providing a safe and secure environment for all who come on our campus, but especially our children. I would like to remind you of some of the things being done to ensure our parish is a safe place for our youth to experience the loving presence of Christ.

All of the catechists who teach our children are long-term and well-known parishioners. Most have been in the catechetical ministry in the parish for many years. Every volunteer who has contact with minors undergoes a state and national criminal background check administered through the diocese. No adult is allowed to be engaged in ministry with minors until they have successfully undergone the back-ground checks and have attended the three-hour *Protecting God's Children* Safe Environment Program, also administered through the diocese. Every 3-5 years all volunteers must redo the background checks and participate in a Safe Environment Program renewal training session. Additionally, each year at the beginning of the religious education program all students watch a video on the elements of a safe environment for themselves and all youth. They did so this past Wednesday. A brochure on this topic, from an adult's perspective, is included in this weekend's bulletin.

In addition to our training program for people, we have done our best to ensure a safe physical environment on campus. We have added extra outdoor lights, especially at doors, that are on sensors to ensure they are lit once the sun sets. Outside doors lock when closed, so that no one can enter the classroom area when religious education is in session. All our classrooms have a 20 X 30-inch window so that classes can be monitored from the hallway. Parents are required to come into the Family Center to pick up their children after class so that no child should be walking the parish campus without an adult. And catechists remain with the children after class until all are picked up by their parents.

All of these safeguards are extremely important, but none of them are meant to replace vigilance. It is the responsibility of each of us to be attentive to what is taking place around us to ensure the safest possible environment for ourselves and all
