- 1. A motion was made to close the KofC 4055 accounts at 5/3 Bank. These accounts include the General Account, the Bingo Account, and the Certificates of Deposit.
- 2. A motion was made to allow a committee of GK Michael Duffy, DGK William Ott, Treasurer Arthur Stanley, FS Paul Nickels, Trustees Paul Baes, Ryan Ott, and Allen Nilson to choose and complete the necessary paperwork to transfer the financial accounts of Fr. Raynold G Thelen Council 4055 of the Knights of Columbus to a new bank or credit union.
- 3. A motion to name Treasurer Arthur Stanley, Grand Knight Michael Duffy, Deputy Grand Knight William Ott, and Trustees Paul Baes, Ryan Ott, and Allen Nilson to be co-signers of the Council 4055 Checking Account.
- 4. A motion to name Bingo Chairmen Paul Nickels, Arthur Stanley, Robert Herman, and William Ott to be co-signers of the Fr Raynold G Thelen Council 4055 Bingo Account.
- 5. A motion to allow the officers of Council 4055 to spend up to \$400 to purchase new checks, deposit slips and stamps for the General Checking account and the Bingo Checking Account.

ALL OF THESE MOTIONS PASSED BY UNANIMOUS VOTE OF THE MEMBERS PRESENT AT THE MARCH 13 GENERAL MEETING.

ONE MORE MOTION---A motion to donate \$1000 to St. Joseph Parish in Watervliet for their Spring Clean-Up project later in the spring. This motion was partially in the current budget.
