



DON'T LEAP FROG THE TRIDUUM

Holy Week provides a unique opportunity that is typically overlooked. The liturgies of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil happen only once a year and are unlike any other – yet, few Catholics experience them. Attending these liturgies makes us present once more to what Jesus experienced during the final days of his earthly life – we walk alongside him, matching steps with the Lord, allowing the thoughts and affections he had to become our own. It is a time of unparalleled prayer and an intense union with Christ.

I want to invite you to make time for this walk with Jesus during the week to come, so that your heart might be more fully opened to and alive to the grace of Easter that we will celebrate next Sunday. Here's a brief synopsis of what happens on these days to whet your appetite:

Holy Thursday – The Mass of the Lord's supper marks the beginning of the Paschal Triduum ("Three Days of Easter"). During this Mass that recounts the Last Supper Jesus had with his apostles, three specific gifts of the Lord are commemorated: the gift of the Holy Eucharist, first celebrated and instituted at the Last Supper; the gift of the Priesthood, as he made the apostles the first priests of his Church at the same Supper; and the gift of Christ's call to service, which he exemplifies by washing his apostles' feet after the supper. To commemorate all three of these, there is a ceremonial washing of the feet of twelve men after the homily.

At the end of this Mass, a solemn procession inside the church recalls Jesus' journey to the Garden of Gethsemane after the Last Supper. Mass finishes with adoration, staying and watching with Christ in the Garden and praying in preparation for his Passion on Good Friday.

Good Friday – The Good Friday Commemoration begins with a silent entrance and a prostration of the priest before the altar as a recognition of our nothingness in light of the love Jesus showed on the Cross. The Passion narrative from John's Gospel is read, a Cross is kissed by the faithful in veneration of the Lord's total self-gift, and Holy Communion is distributed in a communion service before. What most marks this liturgy is its silence. We stand in awe of the redemption won for us and watch Jesus in silence as we remember his lengthy agony on the Cross.

Easter Vigil – The Triduum ends with the celebration of the Easter Vigil. The Easter Candle is lit from a fire outside the church – signifying Christ (the Light of the World) conquering the darkness of sin and death on that night. We read nine readings that give a summary of salvation history. Before the last two readings, we sing the Gloria which recalls the moment of Christ's resurrection on the night of Holy Saturday (the Easter Vigil Gloria marks the official end of Lent). After the homily, the Holy Water font is blessed, all present renew their baptismal promises, and all rejoice in the gift of grace and forgiveness and life that the Resurrection brings. Mass ends the normal way and our walk with Jesus from his last meal on earth, through his passion and death, and into the resurrected glory of that first Easter comes to a close.

There are a thousand other things that will compete for your attention and time this Thursday, Friday, and Saturday. I greatly want you to give that attention and time to Jesus. So, please consider this your invitation to join us for the Triduum – and so to experience the full weight of Easter.

Melt butter. Mix everything with butter. Grease dish.


350 till golden brown 45- 1hr
