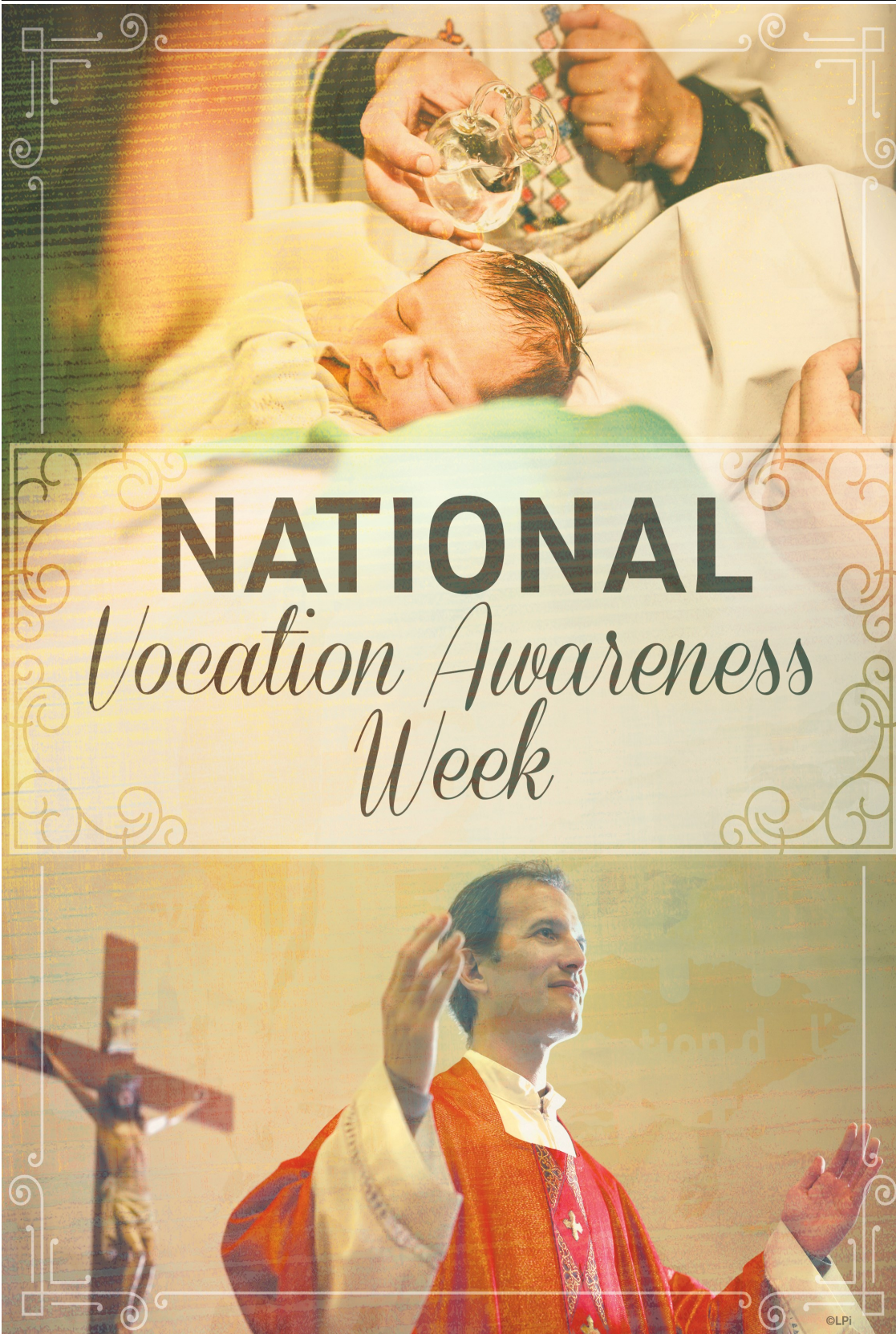

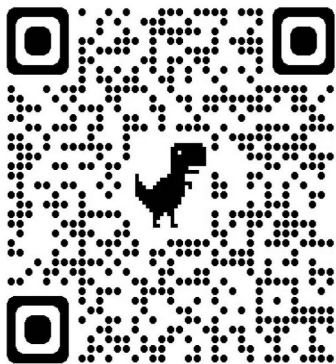
Raffle tickets for the 5 beautiful items: 2 quilts, a painting, a cross and a wine basket will be on sale \$2 each or 3 for \$5.
