## From Father's Desk

My Dear Parish,

This week, on Friday, citizens will gather in the nation's capital for the March for Life. This peaceful demonstration protests the decriminalization of killing unborn children. Prior to 1973, across our country, it was a crime to kill a child in his or her mother's womb. In 1973 those laws were struck down. The slaughter of the most innocent has continued to this day.

In 2022, states were permitted, once again, to criminalize these killings. And many have. But the damage has been done. Estimates vary, but some suggest that over 60 Million little ones have been killed over the past half-century.

In our home state, Marylanders, just a couple of months ago, went to the ballot-box and voted to amend our state constitution in favor protecting the slaughter. We have got a lot of work in front of us if we are going to leave this place better than we found it. Indeed, in Maryland we're going in the wrong direction.

Of course, the moral clarity of the issue could not be more obvious. God's salvation is born of a woman. It is a dark and satanic horror to seek to devour her offspring in her own womb.

Correcting the laws of our states would be a good sign that God's plan is gaining respect. But until that happens, we can all work to promote a culture that honors mothers and children, families and those in-need. We can foster, even socially, the virtues of modesty and chastity and encourage a culture of life—where the most vulnerable are protected.
