The Archdiocese of Louisville is committed to ensuring that children and youth who worship, study, or participate in church-sponsored activities can do so in the safest and most secure setting possible. In an effort to fulfill this commitment, all employees or volunteers who have contact with children or youth (18 and under) for ANY length of time are required to participate in one of the 2-hour Safe Environment Training Workshops. At this time, the **trainings are limited to 50** individuals. All trainings are first come/ first served. No advance registration is necessary. Funeral COVID-19 Guidelines - These are "Healthy at Worship" directives from the Archdiocese of Louisville:

- *All should wear a face covering or mask.
- *Instrumental music may be played, depending on availability of the accompanist.

- *These guidelines also apply to visitations and funerals held in the gym.
- *Seating in the gym is limited to 100 or less.


