Instructions: Write a 1-page, double-spaced essay using font size 12 about your Saint. Remember to put your name on it. You can either turn it in at any of our Confirmation classes, drop it off during office hours or you can email it to:

Use reliable, Catholic resources (books or online). You do not need to site your sources and no plagiarism.

Information that Should be Included in Your Saint Essay:

- A short biography of your saint including when and where he/she lived, his/her feast day, and what is he/she a patron saint of, interesting facts.
- Why you chose that particular saint, with what part of their life do you relate to.
- How you hope to incorporate and imitate him/her into your life in the future.
- Special devotions, traditions, quotes, or prayers associated with him/her.
