- Valid California teaching credential (Multiple Subject or Education Specialist preferred)
- Certification in Special Education or Resource Specialist Program (RSP) credential strongly preferred

- Minimum 2 years teaching experience, ideally in a small group or intervention setting
- Experience providing both push-in (in-class) and pull-out (small group) academic support
