


Stephen Ministry is a service of St. Lorenzo Ruiz to reach out to people who are going through challenging times. It is a one-to-one caring ministry. This past year with the Covid pandemic, we have not been able to reach out in our usual way because of the need for social distancing. Some of the trained Stephen Ministers have been in touch with their care receivers via telecare (phone calls) and social media, but it is not the same as meeting weekly in person with individuals who are struggling with issues of family problems, sickness, death of loved ones, various forms of unhealthy behavior. The Stephen Ministers have been providing caring for members of their own families and other people whom they have been able to meet either in person or through various media. The Stephen Ministers have continued their bi-monthly meetings with others in this ministry via Zoom sessions. Once things open up, we will once again be able to meet face-to-face with persons who need support and care
