REFLECTION 9/24/2021 GOSPEL OF LUKE –

"WHO DO YOU SAY THAT I AM?"

My name is Clem Ruiz. I am blessed to have been a part of a group in the Philippines, headed by the late Fr. Fidel Villarroel, who endeavored to do research and prepare documents for Lorenzo Ruiz to become a "Venerable," then "Blessed" and then finally canonized as "Saint."

Last month, my beloved niece, Joy Marie, was diagnosed with Covid-19 in the Philippines and was confined in ICU. I was very worried and filled with much anxiety. I felt helpless because I could not physically be there for her. Her mother was my late sister who passed away in 2010, and I had taken responsibility over her children whom she left behind.

Although I pray daily for my nieces and nephew, I begged San Lorenzo for his special intercession for Joy Marie. I reminded Joy Marie's children to contact a priest to give their mother the anointing of the sick, to put on her a brown scapular, and pray the rosary. Lastly, I told them to ask for the powerful intercession of San Lorenzo.

Although Joy Marie passed away, I received the special grace of having peace in my heart knowing that she was granted "total and complete healing by our Lord". I believe she is now resting in the loving arms of Jesus.

Through the intercession of San Lorenzo, I have accepted her passing because I had totally entrusted her to our Lord. We are still grieving her loss, but we know that she celebrated her new life and homecoming to her eternal home in the company of San Lorenzo, the angels, and saints. (continued)

...Although my suffering is nothing compared to that of our Lord's and San Lorenzo's, I united my sufferings with theirs. San Lorenzo underwent horrendous suffering during his martyrdom. His Japanese torturers wanted him to renounce his faith in God. Because of San Lorenzo's refusal, the torturers would force buckets of water through a funnel in his mouth until his stomach bloated. Then they put a slab of wood on his stomach and seesawed on it to force out the water from his body and repeated the torture expecting San Lorenzo to renounce his faith in God. Because San Lorenzo remained firm in his faith, they resorted to executing him through a slow death by tying his body tightly with a rope and hanging him upside down over a pit. Even in San Lorenzo's final breath, his faith remained steadfast, and he knew in his heart the answer to Jesus' question "Who do you say that I am?" You are Jesus the Christ, the Son of the Living God!"

Let us thank God for His greatest gift to the Filipinos in giving San Lorenzo to us as our first saint. God bless us all. To God be the glory!



We have the opportunity to cooperate with God in carrying out His work. We put our faith in His will and prayerfully discern how He wishes us to respond.


CONSTANT VIGIL

The visible, public centerpiece of 40 Days for Life is a focused, 40-day, non-stop, round-the-clock prayer vigil outside a single Planned Parenthood center or other abortion facility in your community. It is a peaceful and educational presence. Those who are called to stand witness during this 24-hour-a-day presence send a powerful message to the community about the tragic reality of abortion. It also serves as a call to repentance for those who work at the abortion center and those who patronize the facility.
