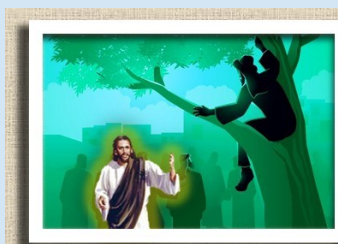
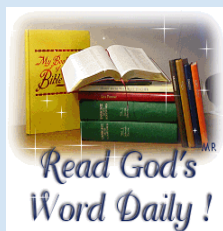
RECONOCE A JESÚS

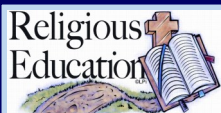
