# Advent Season

"Yes, I am coming soon". Amen! Come, Lord Jesus. (Rev. 22: 20)

A blessed new year to all...a new liturgical year with the Advent season!

Advent simply means 'coming'. Someone is coming. A natural and logical response when someone is coming is to prepare. The more important to us the person who is coming the more important detailed and significant the preparation.

Advent means someone is coming. For us, people of faith – or in our faith life – it is our Lord Jesus. We are vigilant and pray: Come, Lord Jesus come! 'Maranatha'!



Who is Jesus to us will define and dictate our preparation. One time Jesus with his disciples



asks, "who do people say I am?" And the disciples gave many answers...He turns around and asks: "But who do you say I am?

Advent is a sacred and significant time to answer that question of Jesus: Who do you say I am. Our answer will dictate of our own preparation.

Advent means Jesus is coming. He came in humility as a baby, in history. He will come again in glory at the end of time. Jesus however continually comes in our everyday life. He is with us. He is Immanuel ---Let us be vigilant of how he comes and sensitive. Let us pray, sing and dance:

"Rejoice! Rejoice! Emmanuel shall come to thee, O Israel."

#### ADVENT SEASON

"Be vigilant at all times and pray..." (Luke 21:34)

Today marks the beginning of the new liturgical year in the Catholic church and begins with Advent. The Advent season is a time of preparation and a time of anticipation of the birth of Jesus. The Advent wreath is lighted with the first violet candle that represents the theme of hope. The light is a sign of Christ's promise to bring us salvation (Today's Missal, Advent 2021). So even if the Gospel today sounds threatening and full of hopelessness, let the little candlelight reminds us to be watchful, to be ready, and to be prepared to face whatever trials we encounter but most of all to pray unceasingly. Throughout this season of longing, let us invite Jesus into our heart.

#### **First Sunday of Advent**

May you keep your focus on the true meaning of this season as you await the coming of the Lord Jesus and may your life be a proclamation of your belief in Jesus' life and ministry of justice and peace.

In some ways I am a traditionalist. I try to see the importance of what has been "handed over" (*trans* = "over" or "across"; *do* = "giving" or "handing on") from those who have gone before us. The church sees this time of year as a new beginning, a time to focus on what GOD has done in the past, and to look forward to what GOD promise yet to do in the coming days. This is Advent, which is a time of renewal - rededicating ourselves to what is most essential in our lives as followers of the One Who came and Who is coming again. It is particularly hard to do this in our modern society which is focused on celebrating holidays. We are given about four weeks to retreat from the busy-ness of the world and focus on what life is truly all about. Yes, we must be joy-filled, but not with a false sense of merriment, but with a sense of the life which GOD wants us to have, a life with the Lord Jesus Who has come and is coming again.
