Today we celebrate the Central Mystery of our Faith in the Most Holy Trinity!

Our God in three Divine persons! We pray, 'In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, Let us keep the mystery of the Trinity in our hearts not as a mathematical (one in three, three in one) puzzling mystery to resolve. Let us take it rather as a mystery of relationships and love.
