

Info Missionaries of Faith for MCP program



The religious congregation "Missionaries of Faith" was founded in Italy in 1982. Its missions extended to India, Philippines, Samoa, Vietnam, Myanmar, Venezuela, USA, Canada, and the West Indies. In 2002 the Missions in India, Philippines Samoa, Myanmar, Italy, and Vietnam were elevated to the status of Province. The Charism of the Institute is "Faith and Mission".

The mission in India was begun in 1989 with seven priests with its Provincial house in the diocese of Eluru, in the State of Andhra Pradesh. Today there are 82 priests

in the province, and they are working in India in different states, Italy, West Indies, and USA. Its main activities are evangelization, orphanages for the poor children for education, promotion of religious vocation and other charitable works.

The Missionary activities of the Province of India greatly depend upon the providence of God as the Congregation was founded recently. The activities are conditioned sometimes due to the lack of finance. The support we receive from the MCP program will be used generally to support our 78 seminarians who are in the formation, support the more than 600 poor children for the education, other charitable works and the support for opening of new mission parishes.

Archbishop Gomez (partial) letter—*Tuesday*, Aug. 8, 2023

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

This is a time of joy for the family of God here in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles. I know you have been joining me in praying and giving thanks to our Holy Father Pope Francis for his gift of four new Auxiliary Bishops for the Archdiocese.

After prayer, reflection and consultation, I have decided on the following assignments for our new bishops, following their ordinations on September 26th at the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels:

- Auxiliary Bishop Albert M. Bahhuth will serve as the Episcopal Vicar for the San Fernando Pastoral Region,
- Auxiliary Bishop Matthew G. Elshoff, O.F.M. will serve as the Episcopal Vicar for the Our Lady of the Angels Pastoral Region,
- Auxiliary Bishop Brian Nunes will serve as the Episcopal Vicar for the San Gabriel Pastoral Region,
- Auxiliary Bishop Slawomir S. Szkredka will serve as the Episcopal Vicar for the Santa Barbara Pastoral Region.

The Archdiocese's five Pastoral Regions were established in 1986 - the Our Lady of the Angels Pastoral Region, the San Pedro Pastoral Region, the San Fernando Pastoral Region, the San Gabriel Pastoral Region, and the Santa Barbara Pastoral Region. This administrative division continues to serve an important practical function in helping me in my ministry as the Archbishop. In accordance with Church law, Auxiliary Bishops can be appointed as Episcopal Vicars, who have special responsibilities in the pastoral governance of the Archdiocese.

It is important to remember that all of our Auxiliary Bishops are ordained to serve, not only the region they are assigned to, but the entire family of God in Los Angeles. Auxiliary Bishops are called to be true pastors – men of prayer and virtue, men of mercy and men of mission – in the service of the Archdiocese, and in communion with me as the Archbishop and with Pope Francis as the head of the universal Church.

I thank Auxiliary Bishop Alex D. Aclan, for his ministry as Episcopal Vicar for the San Fernando Pastoral Region. We continue to pray for his recovery and look forward to his return to active ministry as an Episcopal Vicar for the Archdiocese.
