



Lenten Reflections from Father Tony:

"Rend your hearts, not your garments, and return to the Lord your God —gracious and

compassionate" (Joel, 2,13)

As we enter this season of **Lent**, we embrace it as a Springtime... a time of revival and renewal ---a Springtime of the Spirit...

This year, as we celebrate a *Jubilee Year* with the theme *Pilgrims of Hope*, we are reminded that Lent is a sacred and prayerful journey of restoration...a spiritual 'resetting' and 'recalculating'. It calls us to "bring the faith home," to allow Christ's love to shape our hearts and transform our daily lives. Like Zacchaeus, we are invited to **come down from our comfort zones**, leaving behind distractions to make space for and stay with Jesus.

Lent is a time to embody grace—*GRACE*, a **G**enerous **R**esponse **A**ccording to **C**hrist's **E**mbrace. It's a call to "**hang out with Jesus**," to journey with Him as *Pilgrims of Hope*, guided by the light of the Holy Spirit. **Each one teach one**, **each one take two**. Let us walk together, encouraging one another, as we listen for God's invitation to open our hearts to the Gospel.

May this Lent be a time of transformation, where we grow in faith, hope, and love, united in our pilgrimage of grace, ever hopeful for the new life that awaits us in Christ.

Today, we dedicate the fifth and most significant statuary of St. Lorenzo Ruiz - a depiction of him as a migrant missionary, carrying a bindle as a sign of faith, journeying into the unknown, bringing Christ to the world.

This statue embodies the heart of our

parish's mission and our journey toward becoming a Diocesan Shrine. It speaks to every pilgrim, migrant, and missionary, reminding us that faith is not meant to be stagnant - it is a call to go forth, to bring light into the world, to carry hope beyond our comfort zones.

Just as St. Lorenzo Ruiz left home and gave his life for Christ, we too are called to **walk in faith**, trusting that our journey, though uncertain, is always guided by God's hand.

Reflection:

St. Lorenzo, you teach us that we are all pilgrims on a journey of faith. Pray for us, that we may follow Christ wherever He calls, carrying hope and love to the ends of the earth.

"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations." (Matthew 28:19)














Come and spend an hour with Jesus

DID YOU KNOW?

Talk to your children about photo sharing

With a cell phone, a photo can be snapped anywhere – out on a walk, in the classroom, even in the locker room or a bathroom. So, it is important to talk to your children about when it is appropriate and when it is not to use a camera and how they should think about sharing images they take. Any image they send is shared permanently, and they cannot get those images back. If someone asks your child for an inappropriate photo, he or she should notify a trusted adult immediately.
