


HOPE and Happiness

"Take care to guard against all greed, for though one may be rich, one's life does not consist of possessions." (Luke 12:15)

As a Girl Scout in 6th grade, the first motto is, 'Be prepared!' Be ready to help wherever it is needed. At an early age, scouting is one example of preparing the young for a life of bigger challenges. I heard my mother tell the girls in the family to be prepared for married life "To study hard, have a profession, get a good paying job, be savvy with money, and never be dependent on your husband's income and support. You'll never know what will happen to your married life. Will he always be there to support you? Will he be faithful to you? You must be ready to face these hardships." This was not the advice I needed to hear at an early age. But I studied hard, completed a degree, practiced my profession, worked, and spent my money wisely. Saving money for retirement is part of the new employee orientation when I started working here in the USA. All things that we possess cannot be accommodated in the final resting place. What about our soul? Our hope is to be with God, our Father who has prepared a dwelling place for us.

growth..





What is the VIRTUS program?

The core of VIRTUS Program is preventing child sexual abuse by educating adults about the issue and equipping them with tools to create safer environments.

VIRTUS training is often mandatory for adults who work with children in various settings, including churches, schools, and other organizations. Key Elements: The program emphasizes recognizing warning signs of abuse, controlling access to children, monitoring programs, being aware of children's behavior, and communicating concerns. The VIRTUS Program is designed to be proactive rather than reactive, aiming to prevent abuse from occurring in the first place.

OCIA (the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults - formerly called the RCIA - Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) prepares adults to receive one or more of the Sacraments of Initiation. The Sacraments of Initiation are Baptism, Confirmation, and First Eucharist [Communion]. OCIA's primary focus is on people who have never been baptized as a Christian. OCIA also prepares adults to be received into the Catholic Church if they have been baptized in another Christian church. If a person was baptized as a Catholic but never received First Eucharist or Confirmation, they can also be a part of the OCIA. We also have people who have received all their Sacraments of Initiation but just want to deepen their understanding of the Catholic faith.



DID YOU KNOW?

Who do children talk to about abuse? Studies show that when children know that adults are willing to believe them, and advocate for them, children are more willing to come to adults with their problems. This is why other safe adults, like teachers and youth ministry volunteers, are essential to child protection. If a child discloses abuse, it is critical for a safe adult to provide a listening ear and help when needed, including reporting to the right people and authorities.
