

WE ARE UNITED IN CHRIST

The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches us that the Church is one because of her source: "the highest exemplar and source of this mystery is the unity, in the Trinity of Persons, of one God, the Father and the Son in the Holy Spirit." The Church is one because of her founder: for "the Word made flesh, the prince of peace, reconciled all men to God by the cross, . . . restoring the unity of all-in-one people and one body." The Church is one because of her "soul": "It is the Holy Spirit, dwelling in those who believe and pervading and ruling over the entire Church, who brings about that wonderful communion of the faithful and joins them together so intimately in Christ that he is the principle of the Church's unity." (CCC, 813)

Saint Paul in his First Letter to the
Corinthians describes the Church as one body
with many members distinct among
themselves, but one with Christ their head:
"For in one Spirit we are all baptized into one
body, whether Jews or Gentiles, whether bond
or free." (1 Cor. 12:13). He further explains the
same truth in his Letter to the Ephesians and
exhorts us to be "careful to keep the unity of
the Spirit in the bond of peace", reminding us
that there is but "one body and one spirit—
one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and
Father of all." (Eph. 4:3-6).

Growing in unity through Christ involves cultivating love, humility, forgiveness, cooperation, patience, and wisdom within the Christian community, showing the character of Christ. It's a process of spiritual growth, where we grow and mature in our knowledge, understanding and love of Christ and His teachings, becoming more like Him and working together to build up the body of Christ.

In spirit, growing in unity through Christ involves embracing and sharing our faith; valuing diverse gifts; living-out the virtues of humility and love; and actively working on reconciliation and peace.

Today's readings invite us to reflect on what it truly means to follow God with courage, patience, and a heart full of trust in His promises. In the first reading from Jeremiah 38:4-6, 8-10, the prophet Jeremiah finds himself in serious trouble for speaking God's truth. His message was not what people wanted to hear, which led to him being thrown into a muddy pit, a dark and hopeless place. Jeremiah's story reminds us that being faithful is not always easy; sometimes it can lead to misunderstanding, discomfort, rejection, or even dangerous situations. Yet God did not abandon Jeremiah. He always provides help and sends people into our lives to lift us when we are stuck in our own "muddy pits" of fear, doubt, and hardship, just as He sent someone to rescue Jeremiah.

The Psalm reassures us that no matter how deep our struggles may be, God hears our cries, acts in His perfect timing, and restores our footing so we can walk forward in faith. In the second reading from Hebrews 12:1-4, we are encouraged to "run with perseverance the race that lies before us" by fixing our eyes on Jesus, who endured the cross for our salvation. This reading reminds us that following Christ is not a short journey but a lifelong race, where we must let go of sin, discouragement, and anything that weighs us down along the way. In the Gospel from Luke 12:49-53, Jesus speaks about bringing "fire" to the earth and how His mission will cause division even among families and friends. He is not encouraging conflict for its own sake. Rather, this "fire" is the purifying presence of the Holy Spirit; God's power cleanses and transforms our hearts.

As difficult and troubling as it can be at times, we have faith that God will be with us. Together, these readings remind us that living as disciples of Christ is not always comfortable, but it is always worth it. God asks us to be brave, courageous, to stay strong when our faith is tested, and to trust that He will guide us through every challenge. I continue to thank God for all the people that He has personally sent in my life as I walk in my faith journey. I'm blessed to call them my friends and family. The community that he has blessed me with and the friendships that have formed make my heart warm.

This week, let us pray for the courage to live our faith openly and the perseverance to keep our eyes on Jesus, no matter what comes our way. May we welcome the "fire" of the Holy Spirit to burn away fear, selfishness, and complacency so that we can live with love, kindness, and joy of true disciples.



OCIA (the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults formerly called the RCIA - Rite of Christian Initiation

of Adults) prepares adults to receive one or more of the Sacraments of Initiation. The Sacraments of Initiation are Baptism, Confirmation, and First Eucharist [Communion]. OCIA's primary focus is on people who have never been baptized as a Christian. OCIA also prepares adults to be received into the Catholic Church if they have been baptized in another Christian church. If a person was baptized as a Catholic but never received First Eucharist or Confirmation, they can also be a part of the OCIA. We also have people who have received all their Sacraments of Initiation, but just want to deepen their understanding of the Catholic faith.

or people living in developing countries around the world, lack of access to traditional financial services keeps them from providing for their material needs. A Catholic Relief Services (CRS) program has created Savings and Internal Lending Communities (SILCs) to address this lack by helping poor communities to pool savings, which then can be lent to SILC members to build or grow businesses at low cost. In Chad, Claudine, a mother of six, uses loans from her local SILC to buy large, lower-cost quantities of the ingredients she needs to make the beignets she sells at market. Before the SILC was established, Claudine was barely able to sell enough beignets to live. But now these cost savings allow her to care for her family and pay school

The core of VIRTUS Program is preventing child sexual abuse by educating adults about the issue and equipping them with tools to create safer environments.

VIRTUS training is often mandatory for adults who work with children in various settings, including churches, schools, and other organizations. Key Elements: The program emphasizes recognizing warning signs of abuse, controlling access to children, monitoring programs, being aware of children's behavior, and communicating concerns.

The VIRTUS Program is designed to be proactive rather than reactive, aiming to prevent abuse from occurring in the first place.
