




OCIA (the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults – formerly called the RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation

of Adults) prepares adults to receive one or more of the Sacraments of Initiation. The Sacraments of Initiation are Baptism, Confirmation, and First Eucharist [Communion]. OCIA's primary focus is on people who have never been baptized as a Christian. OCIA also prepares adults to be received into the Catholic Church if they have been baptized in another Christian church. If a person was baptized as a Catholic but never received First Eucharist or Confirmation, they can also be a part of the OCIA. We also have people who have received all their Sacraments of Initiation, but just want to deepen their understanding of the Catholic faith.

Some key points I suggest: Will only few people be saved? A question that comes from anybody who is interested in salvation.

Who wants the sure way
Or somebody who cares not only for his own but
for all.

Sad reality: to others salvation is no longer important. They do not care about what's beyond this earthly life. They care only about their life on the world.

Salvation is a grace given by Christ out from His goodness and love. It's a gift but needs our own effort to acquire it, something that we give our whole life actually. There's no minute in our life that passes ignoring this.

Jesus's answer: Strive to enter the narrow gate.
Salvation in an invitation to enter the Home of
God, heavenly kingdom. It is the ultimate
experience of what we echo in the parish,
"Welcome Home!"



We pass through a narrow door, a point of entry that invites everybody. But not everybody is willing to enter. For what does a narrow door mean to everybody. For some a narrow door just gives inconvenience or discomfort, a difficult way to follow. Others might not fit themselves to it simply because they opt for the wide door of comfort, the easy way.

The narrow door though is still open for anybody who opts to enter into it. But how can we do that? We must recognize that countless keys are always available right just before us. These keys are the values of the kingdom of God: love, faith, hope, humility and selfless service to God, prayers and others. It is simply following what Christ demands of a true discipline: whoever wants to follow me must deny himself, takes up his cross and follow me! Sounds uninviting and difficult! But it comes as an attractive challenge and opportunity who really appreciate what Christ wants us for us ,to achieve glorious life through sacrifices and death to worldy values of selfishness and pride that leads us to

ignore God over material things and pleasure
To choice sin simply shuts the door for the kingdom
of God. Know that it is our own choice to suffer our
fate. But with a constant fidelity to the Lord we are
assured of entering the kingdom of God and would
never regret not attempting even a single time in
our lifetime.
