- Anyone who supervises or is perceived to supervise children in any way is required to submit to a background check in the form of fingerprinting by the Los Angeles Archdiocese. All St. Lorenzo Ruiz students/youth will take part annually in the "Teaching Touching Safety" or other approved safe environment education program.
