

The Deacon's Digression

Dear Friends,

Today's Gospel narrates a familiar story. Jesus calls his first disciples while walking along the shore of the Sea of Galilee. All four were commercial fishermen. Jesus famously tells Peter and his brother Andrew "Come. I will make you fishers of men."

Before we even get to the call story, we learn about John the Baptist's arrest and Jesus's appearance in the Galilee, the northern boondocks of Israel. (Last we heard Jesus was down near Jerusalem getting baptized in the Jordan River, about 80 miles to the south.). Mark has now set the stage for Jesus's very first words in this Gospel.

"This is the time of fulfillment. The Kingdom of God is at hand."

Israel's centuries-long wait for God to fulfill his promise to send a messiah is over. Jesus tells us that a new era has begun, The Kingdom of God is no longer something that will come in the distant future. It is here. Now.

These are beautiful opening words, full of hope. Full of promise. The rest of Mark's Gospel narrates how these first dozen words were received and how they were understood. How his opponents were not simply Messiah-deniers. They would ultimately see to Jesus's death. How the Kingdom of God is breaking into the prevailing reality—giving believers, just a foretaste of the eternal life to come.

So buckle your seatbelts. Mark is just beginning his wild ride.
