## Message from the Pastor

Dear St. Louis Community,

As a background...The life of the shepherd, in biblical times, was one of personal self-giving and sacrifice. His work was that of watchful care and staying close to the flock. In Palestine, the shepherd brought the sheep into the sheepfold every night. It consisted of a circular stone wall with an opening or door where the sheep would enter. Once the sheep were inside for the night, the shepherd slept in that opening or door all night. The sheep could not get out without stepping over the shepherd's body, which meant they could not wander at all during the night.

Jesus is the gate and anyone who enters through Him will be safe, will go freely in and out, and will be sure of finding pasture. Others may steal or kill or destroy, but Jesus is the Good Shepherd!

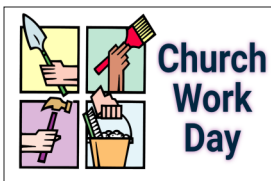
