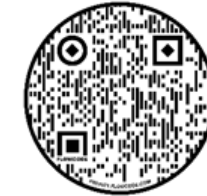

Letter from the Pastor

Sr. Ann had a touching and well deserved send off this week. She served for so many years as a Sister of Mercy in catholic education, hospice chaplain work, missionary efforts in Peru and 33 years in our parish. She began the Spanish Apostolate and with Fr. McNamara began the process of welcoming people in our midst. She led RCIA education, visiting the sick, organizing our parish trips. She did it so well. She was one of us. She will be missed and her legacy will always be a part of us.

We thank Clark for giving us the use of the whole parking lot and Sergeant Fred Gehring who worked so hard to take care of this.

Our pew counting results are in the bulletin. You will see that our numbers are down. It's true everywhere.

There are petitions at the doors of the church advocating for an end to infanticide. For various reasons people don't want a baby and that baby is allowed to die. That's insane, cruel and depraved but proposed by many of our representatives.

Our young adults group is planning a walk-hike this Saturday. They will go to Rutland State Park. If you want to go please see the info below.

We welcome Bishop McManus to our parish for the annual CCHD awards ceremony. The Diocesan Catholic Campaign for Human Development operates out of our rectory.

In the first reading a widow was depressed, hungry and waiting to die. The Prophet Elijah told her to get moving and bake a cake. She got moving ate and lived.

Now there's good advice when we feel like giving up we have to get moving and do something. Hebrews tells us to imitate Jesus, the great high priest and not the priest parading around in long robes and ripping off widows.

They offer lengthy prayers. It's a pretext. It's a lie.

He then uses the example of the widow who gave all she had.

In the two readings both widows had little but they had everything.

They eventually realized what they had mattered.

We are going through a period of living in a wasteland.

But we have to keep moving, do what we can and know that we are making a difference Steady as she goes

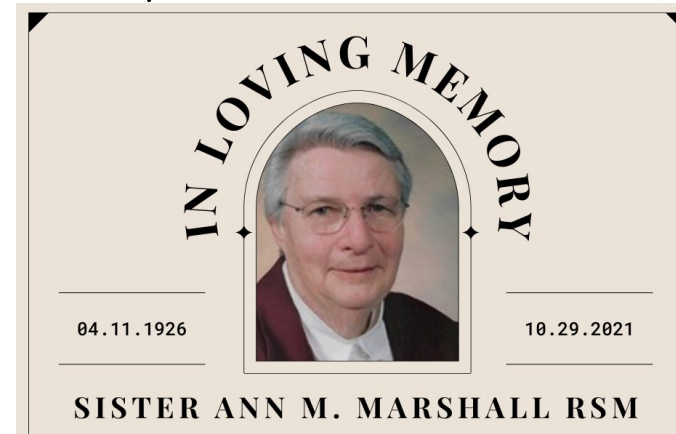
