

THE RITE OF ELECTION

The Rite of Election is the second step on the catechumens' journey toward Baptism. The Church chooses those it deems ready for initiation and leads them into the more intense period of Lenten preparation. Those chosen, inscribe their names in the BOOK OF THE ELECT as a promise of faithfulness to the call they have received from Christ. At the Easter Vigil, they will be baptized, confirmed and receive Eucharist. Thus, they will be fully initiated into the Body of Christ.

Today, we have three catechumens who will be participating in the Rite of Election which will take place at 2:30pm, at the Guardian Angel Cathedral:

This celebration will begin with the Rite of Sending, where each catechumen will sign their names in the BOOK OF THE ELECT. This ritual takes place during the mass (Ngan Cao and Mara Gonzalez at the 8:00am Mass and Deja Jones at the 11:00am Mass).
