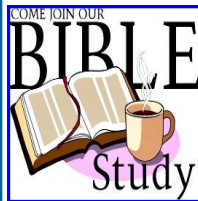

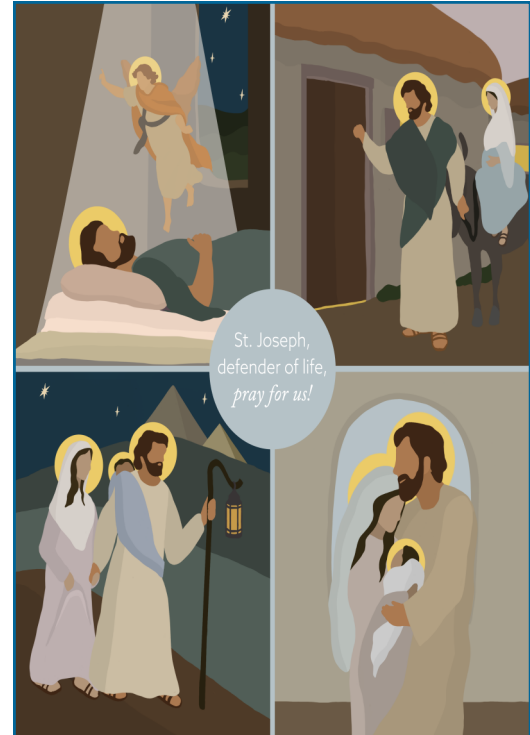

### True Presence Nights Begin at 7:00pm

Archbishop Aymond will preside over five regional Eucharistic events held in parishes throughout the archdiocese in the fall of 2021.
