

How often do we put all our time and energy into building a kingdom here on earth, forgetting that life here is short? The real kingdom is in the next life. Yet, how much time and energy do we invest in working for that eternal kingdom?

Pastor's Column

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Today is the last Sunday of the Liturgical Year - the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe: the same Jesus we find on the Cross; the same Jesus who will judge us in justice and mercy, the same Jesus we are waiting for, waiting to see and to know face to face, and heart to heart.

Our First Reading from the Prophet Daniel tells us that "His dominion is everlasting" and so it is that "all peoples, nations, and languages serve him." The Second Reading from Revelation reminds us that because Jesus "has freed us from our sins by his blood," He has thus "made us into a kingdom," He has made each and all of us "priests for his God and Father." And finally, in the Gospel of John, Pilate struggles to comprehend as he asks: "Are you the King of the Jews?" And indeed He is!

All of our readings today point to the fact that there will be Final Days; that there will be a final and individual judgment of each and every one of us. The lives we have lived on earth will be the criteria for being received by Jesus into eternal life.

A year ago, at the Mass for my Installation as pastor, I recounted the dream a young friend had in which he was standing at the gates of heaven, awaiting Jesus' decision on admission - "yea" or "nay." In the dream, Jesus kept looking past, over, around him. Finally he asked, "Jesus, what are you looking for?" Jesus replied, "I'm just looking to see who else you brought with you!"

My brothers and sisters, in these last days of the Liturgical Year, which suggest the last days before the Final Judgment, this would be an excellent question to bring into our daily prayer with Jesus! How wonderful that you and I celebrate Mass each week, but that is not enough! Who did you bring with you?


Jesus' question, "who else did you bring with you?" touches directly the reality of how you and I have lived the mission He gave each one of us to "go and make disciples of all nations."

Does our participation in the Eucharist – which is fundamental and essential - manifest itself in our lives in such a way that, despite the joys and sorrows of life, others are drawn to you, asking, "what is the source of your joy?" Do you invite them, as Jesus did, to "come and see"?
