A Message from Fr. Vincent



Dear Friends:

Happy Lent!!! We have now begun our Lenten journey. Ash Wednesday here at OLM was absolutely wonderful. I had the opportunity to meet so many people that I have not yet had the opportunity to meet since I've arrived at OLM in September.

During these 40 days, it is a good time for us to think of how we want to transform our hearts into doing what Jesus is asking of each of us – renewing ourselves spiritually so that we are different people on Easter Sunday than we were on Ash Wednesday. We know that the most significant annual opportunities for spiritual attention and renewal for all of us are the faithful timeless practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.

Jesus said that God does not like it when people do righteous deeds just to look good in front of others. For example, when giving to the poor, “do not blow a trumpet before you, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets to win the praise of others.” Jesus also said, referring to the scribes and Pharisees, “But when you give alms, do not let your left hand know what your right is doing, so that your almsgiving may be secret. And your Father who sees in secret will repay you.”

Jesus said the same thing regarding prayer. “When you pray, do not be like the hypocrites, who love to stand and pray in the synagogues and on street corners so that others may see them,” he warned. “But when you pray, go to your inner room, close the door, and pray to your Father in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will repay you.”

And he taught that those who are fasting shouldn't look as if they were. “When you fast, do not look gloomy like the hypocrites. They neglect their appearance, so that they may appear to others to be fasting,” he said. “But when you fast, anoint your head and wash your face, so that you may not appear to be fasting, except to your Father who is hidden. And your Father who sees what is hidden will repay you.”

In order to defeat the fundamental human weakness known as self-centeredness and focus as Christ wants us to on God and others, we must turn our eyes away from ourselves and our passions, and direct them to God and to those around us. The most proven way to do this is through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Whether it's Lent or not, give them a try—you won't regret it!

Also, Cardinal Tobin wrote a beautiful Pastoral Letter titled “Returning to Grace: A Pastoral Letter on the Eucharist from Cardinal Tobin”. I have attached it to this message. As we begin our journey of Lent together, please read this incredibly beautiful and important message from the Cardinal.

Finally, as you know, Pope Francis has declared that this year is the **Year of Saint Joseph**. Each week, I will place a different prayer or reflection in my message for you to enjoy. I hope you enjoy it.

Memorare to Saint Joseph

Remember, O most chaste spouse of the Virgin Mary, that never was it known that anyone who implored your help and sought your intercession was left unassisted.

Full of confidence in your power I fly unto you and beg your protection. Despise not O Guardian of the Redeemer my humble supplication, but in your bounty, hear and answer me. Amen.

- ◆ The second part of my Lenten talk "God Is Love" will be on Sunday, March 7th at 7 p.m. in the Church. Please sign up on the Parish website. The event will also be live-streamed. The focus of this talk will be "Knowing God's Love for Us Through His Mercy". The talk will conclude with Eucharistic Adoration and praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet.
- ◆ With respect to the Annual Appeal from the Archdiocese, I thank each of you who has already given to or made a pledge toward the Appeal. The Appeal helps so many in need around the four counties of our Archdiocese and beyond through Catholic Charities, Hospital and Prison Ministry, Ministry to Persons with Disabilities, Respect Life Office (including Mercy House and Pro-Life Efforts) and Protecting God's Children. Funds raised also help in:

Proclaiming the Gospel – Ministry to Multi-Ethnic Communities; Office of Evangelization; Office of Family Life; International Missions; and Ministry to the Deaf.

Forming Future Priests and Supporting Retired Clergy – Continued Formation for Priests; Seminarian Education; and Priest Health Care.

Passing on the Faith – Office of Youth and Young Adult Ministry; Catechetical Office; Campus Ministry and affiliated Colleges & Universities; Catholic Schools.

As you know from my past messages, the goal set for our Parish is \$109,317. Any amounts collected over this goal will be returned to the Parish to help us in our Parish mission. Any amount under this goal will still be the responsibility of each Parish to pay to the Archdiocese.





R.C.I.A. is designed to welcome adults into our Catholic faith. Preparation is a year-long ongoing process culminating at the Easter Vigil Mass. The goal is to receive the Sacraments of Baptism (for non-Christians), Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist.

IS RCIA FOR YOU or SOMEONE YOU KNOW? Do you know someone or are you someone who is interested in becoming Catholic? Are you Catholic but have not yet received all of the Sacraments of Initiation (Confirmation and Eucharist)?

The RCIA is a process of prayer, reflection, and learning that allows for the continual discernment of God's will in our lives. Candidates include: · Non-baptized adults, who wish to enter the Catholic Church · Baptized adult Christians of another denomination (i.e. Lutheran, Anglican, Presbyterian), who wish to continue their Christian faith in the Catholic Church · Adult baptized Catholics, who have not completed the Sacraments of Initiation (Holy Communion and/or Confirmation) and wish to do so. 


A Journey toward Healing and Hope
