

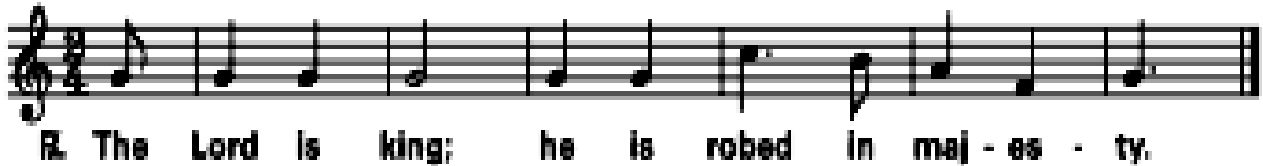
FIRST READING

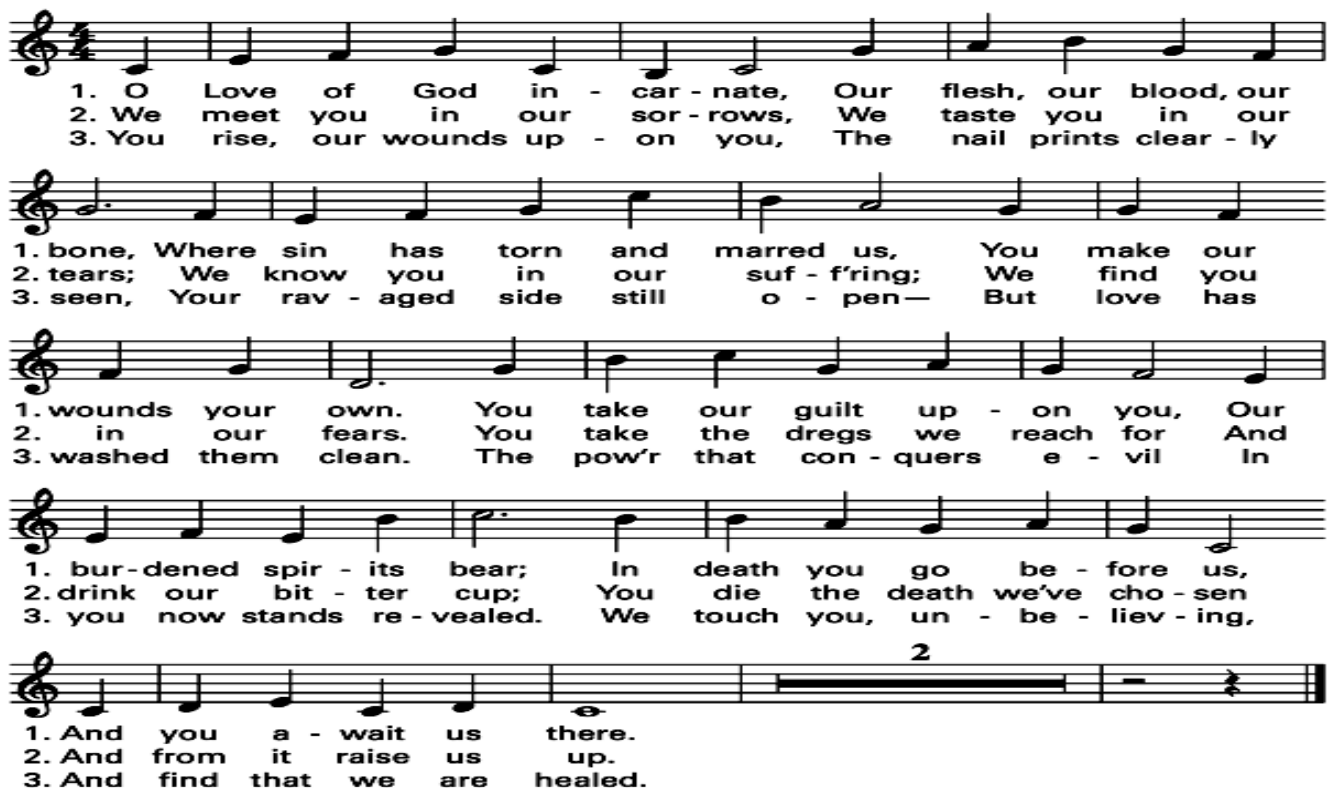

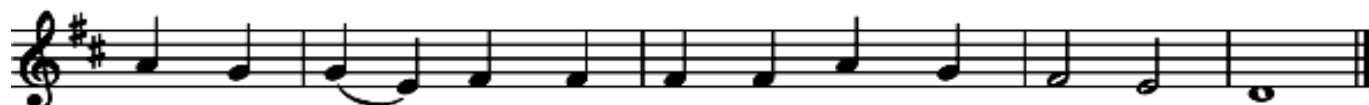

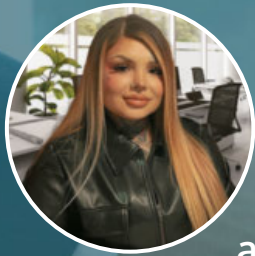
