This Week’s Liturgical Readings

December 26th, 2021 – Feast of the Holy Family

- 1) 1 Samuel 1:20-22, 24-28
- 2) 1 John 3:1-2, 21-24
- 3) Luke 2:41-52

FOCUS: *Did you not know what I must be in my Father’s House?*

Jesus is the Son of God, sent out of love to do the Father’s will. Out of love, He obeys. Through the life of sacrifice of Jesus, we become children of God and heirs to the Kingdom, which in turn requires of us, in love, to *keep His commandments and do what pleases Him*. As Christ was meant to be in His Father’s house, so too, we are meant to join Him: in worship here in this life and for eternity, in the next. We do this through love of God and one another, with the help of the Spirit He gave us.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, Hannah bears a son and offers him to the Lord. John writes that the Father’s love bestowed on us has allowed us to be *called the children of God*, and we should...*love one another just as He commanded us*. In the Gospel, Mary, and Joseph search for Jesus *with great anxiety*. After they find Him in the temple, Jesus explains that He had to be in His Father’s house.

Our parish preparation will begin the week of January 17. We will
offer the possibility to join a small group for discussion. Everyone's
opinion counts! Some groups will be in-person, others via zoom;
groups will meet on different days and at different times in the
morning, afternoon and evening to accommodate available times
and preferences of as many parishioners as possible. Groups will
meet once a week for 3 weeks only to discuss the questions that
have been proposed. Volunteer sign-up will begin Jan. 3, 2022.
