FOCUS: MAKE YOUR HEARTS FIRM, BECAUSE THE COMING OF THE LORD IS AT HAND.

On Gaudete Sunday we rejoice with all the earth in anticipation & preparation for Jesus' birth & the coming of his kingdom. We, like John the Baptist, are blessed & included in the kingdom of heaven, not because of what we do but what Jesus does for us.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, Isaiah describes how the earth will rejoice when the Lord comes to save his people. In the second reading, James encourages patient hearts, for the return of the Lord is at hand. In the Gospel, Jesus praises John the Baptist as God's messenger & assures John's disciples that he is the one John has been seeking.

World Youth Day 2023 – Lisbon & Fatima, Portugal

WYD 2023

Bishop Crosby is sending a delegation of 40 young adults to World Youth Day 2023. World Youth Day (WYD) is the gathering of Catholic young people from all over the world with the Pope. For the millions of participants, it is a pilgrimage, a celebration of youth, an expression of



the universal Church, and an intense moment of evangelization for the world. Mary Forcier, our youth minister, is one of the delegates.

The WYD 2023 pilgrimage and celebration will take place July 28 – August 7, 2023 in Lisbon and Fatima, Portugal. While on pilgrimage, delegates will get to experience the Portuguese history, culture, and food. They will also participate in a retreat experience in Fatima, joining millions of young Catholics in prayer and celebration, and journey with the Holy Father through a powerful overnight vigil, closing with a Papal Mass.

"MARY AROSE AND WENT WITH HASTE"

Mary arose and went with haste" (Lk 1:39) has been chosen by Pope Francis as the motto of the World Youth Day 2023. The phrase opens the account of the Visitation, following the Annunciation. Mary of Nazareth is the great figure of the Christian journey. She teaches us to say yes to God. She was the protagonist of the last WYD and will be so again in Lisbon.

Addressing young people in particular, challenging them to be courageous missionaries, Pope Francis wrote in his exhortation Christus Vivit: "Where does Jesus send us? There are no borders, no limits: he sends us everywhere. The Gospel is for everyone, not just for some" (CV 177).
