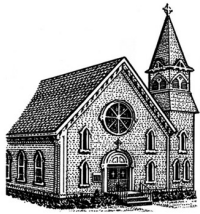

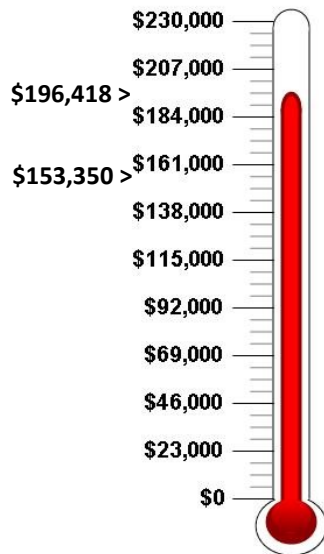

Pet Blessing

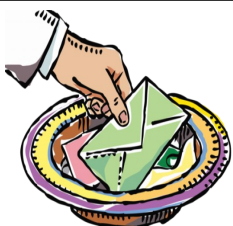
