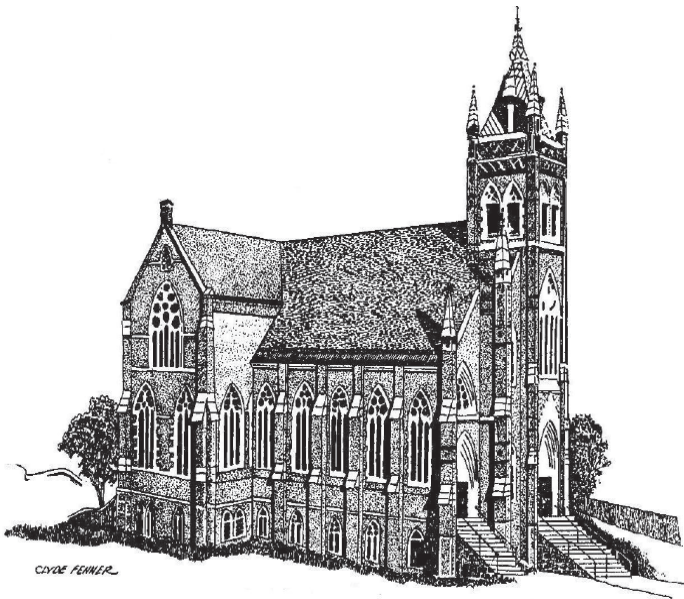

Dear Friends,

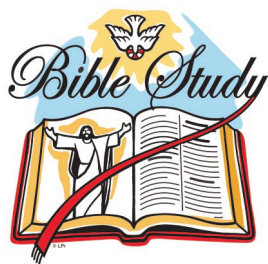

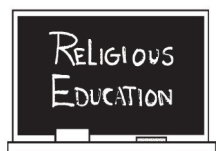

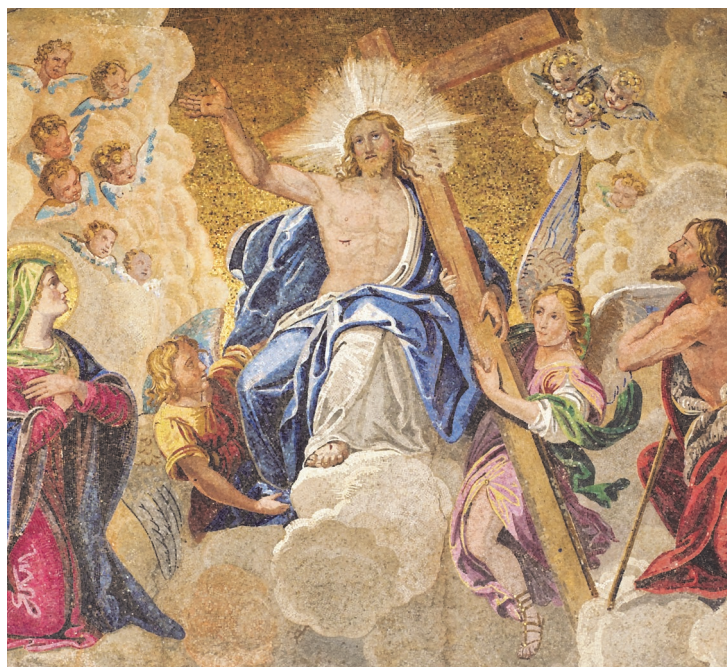

Fr. Nally & Fr. Ramirez are asking that you call the Rectory if you have a family member that will be spending time in the hospital. They would like to be able to visit.



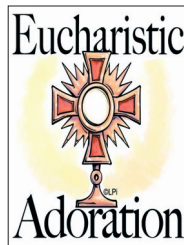
The staff at St. John's Cemetery would like to remind parishioners that winter decorations may be placed at the cemetery one
