# St. John the Guardian of Our Lady

Dear Friends,

We are very pleased to add additional Masses during the week at our beloved parish.

From our many conversations with you over these past six weeks, it is clear that 1) an additional daily Mass is desired, 2) a Mass every Saturday morning in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary is desired, and 3) holy day of obligation Masses offered a bit later in the evening is desired.

We cannot think of more wonderful requests for parish priests to receive! At a time when some Catholic Churches are reducing their Mass schedules, St. John's Church desires to increase its Mass schedule. Thanks be to God.

We have been praying about these possibilities for some weeks. In the end, we chose particular times based upon a number of factors and schedules.

We are pleased to announce that we will offer Monday through Friday 6pm Masses, a Monday morning 7am Mass, and an 8am Mass every Saturday morning, effective Monday, August 19, 2019. Regarding holy days of obligation, the Mass schedule will be 6pm-Vigil, 7am, 12:10pm & 7pm.

The 7am Monday through Friday daily Mass will remain in the Our Lady of Guadalupe Chapel. The Monday through Friday 6pm Mass, and the Saturday morning 8:00am Mass, however, will be offered in the upper Church.

Only during wedding rehearsals, and for a period over particularly cold winter months, will this Mass location transition to the Our Lady of Guadalupe Chapel.

In these circumstances, brightly painted signs communicating this change clearly will be visible at the bottom steps of the church entrances, recommending that you park in the rear of the Church for lower church entry.

Eucharistic adorers in the Our Lady of Guadalupe Chapel "interrupted" by these occasional changes of Mass locations we are sure will be forgiving. The only thing more sublime than adoring our Lord is to receive Him at Mass!

A sacred time for silent prayer will be offered before and after these new 6pm and 8am Masses. No devotions are scheduled at this time. The celebrant will recruit individuals from the assembly to assist at Mass as needed.

Further, at this time, all 7am Monday morning Masses, and all Wednesday and Friday 6pm Masses will be offered for the poor souls in Purgatory—"that they may be loosed from their sins" (2Macc 12:46), and "achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven" (CCC, 1030).

All Saturday morning Masses will be offered for "the family," under the Blessed Virgin Mary's patronage as "Queen of Families."

In a special way each Saturday morning, we will ask for our Blessed Mother's powerful intercession for the protection of the "domestic church" that is, the family, and that all of our loved ones who presently are not practicing their faith may tenderly and lovingly be guided back to the Church and her lifegiving Sacraments.

On the following four holidays, only one Mass will be offered at 8am: Labor Day, Columbus Day, Thanksgiving Day & Memorial Day. One Mass on Veterans Day will be offered at 10am.

Our annual Miraculous Medal Novena Masses on the weekdays of October 7 through 11 will remain at 7pm.

Weekday Masses during the Lenten weekdays will be offered at 7am, 12:10pm and 6pm.

For those of you who presently have 5:15pm Monday Mass intentions scheduled for your loved ones, may we have your permission to transition these 45 minutes later to the new 6pm Monday Mass? If this presents a hardship for any family, we will be pleased to celebrate both 5:15pm and 6pm Masses on these Mondays to honor the originally scheduled Mass time. Please contact us if this is preferred.

May this greater availability to receive every day the Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ in the Eucharist, unite us ever closer to Him.


