

Dear Friends,

On the weekend of March 21 & 22 our parish will participate in the annual fundraising efforts that fund more than 25 diocesan agencies, ministries and programs. For some years now this campaign has been called "Partners in Charity." When I was a kid growing up in Spencer, a couple of dads from the neighborhood would walk from door to door gathering donations for this same cause. Remember those days? It was called "The Bishop's Fund" back then.

Although a few things have changed over the decades regarding the name of the campaign, and how one may now give (online, by text, by phone, and in-pew), the need to fund these important agencies, ministries and programs that help thousands of souls throughout the diocese each year steadily continues.

Your generosity to this program back in the late '90s made it possible for me to earn my Theology degree from St. Mary's Seminary in Baltimore to prepare for priestly ordination. The same holds true for Fr. Sebastian's studies in English and Theology from 2014 to 2018 at Clark University and St. Mary's Seminary in Baltimore. Presently, you assist familiar names such as Zack Sullivan, Victor Henao and Rafael Longhini – our seminarians. These are just a few examples from only one of the agencies of our Diocese – the Office for Priestly Vocations.

Examples of other ministries include the Respect Life Office, Catholic Charities, Campus Ministry, Youth Ministry, and the Office of Marriage and Family.

Last year's Partners in Charity Appeal goal was 5 million dollars. Thanks to everyone's efforts, \$4,760,000 was raised. Our parish goal last year was \$92,800, and we exceeded that by an additional \$508. Thank you! Our parish goal remains the same this year at \$92,800.

Over the coming weekends you'll hear a bit more about our efforts to reach our goal. Fr. Sebastian and I thank you for your extraordinary generosity in the past that helped us reach our very happy days of ordination, and we thank you in advance, for your future generosity that will touch many lives in our Diocese.

Next Saturday, March 14, will be a special day in our parish with both Confirmations in the morning (10am), and our St. Patrick's Dinner in the evening (Serving 5pm to 7pm, with continued celebrating thereafter). I hope you can join us for one or both of these joyous occasions!

Guidelines for Fast & Abstinence

PRAY FAST GIVE Lenten fast and abstinence regulations for the Diocese of Worcester are as follows:

- Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics fourteen (14) years of age and older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent.
- Fasting is to be observed by all Catholics who are eighteen (18) years of age but not yet fifty-nine (59) years of age on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- Those who are bound to fast may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.
