

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

The Sacrament of Baptism is offered every Sunday at 12:00 noon. Please make arrangements for the Pre-Baptismal instructions after the birth of the child in person at the rectory.

Pre-instruction for both parents is required.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

Arrangements must be made at the rectory in person by the couple. Where possible, arrangements should be made one year in advance and no later than six months.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING

Communal anointings of the sick are celebrated.

Individual anointings may be celebrated anytime by request.

HOSPITAL AND HOME VISITATION

Please notify the parish of any family member who may be ill at home or in the hospital. We welcome the opportunity of visiting them and bringing them the Eucharist.

Dear Parishioners of Saint Francis of Assisi,

Recently Governor Lamont has announced that as of May 19, some further lifting of restrictions connected to the pandemic will take place, most notably the requirement for social distancing. As the result of this, all the Bishops of Connecticut have reinstituted the obligation to attend (to end the general dispensation) Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of obligation in person effectively the Vigil Mass on Saturday, May 22, 2021 (Solemnity of Pentecost).

However, some parishioners may have desire to return to Mass in person to be with the rest of our parish community but are prevented from doing so for legitimate reasons such as: (1) suffering from serious pre-existing conditions; (2) being ill and homebound or being a caregiver in close contact with someone who is; (3) having tested positive for any contagious disease, including Covid-19; (4) being in quarantine. For anyone

facing these circumstances, you are being excused from attending Mass in person. In addition, starting May 19, the following guidelines will be implemented here at Saint Francis of Assisi Parish:

- 1. No social distancing is required inside the church. Most pews are available for seating. For those who are vulnerable or uncomfortable, we will have reserved 4 pews in the back of the church and the choir loft for social distancing. Please tell the ushers once you entered the church.
- 2. Masks are required in church, but not outside including the parking lot.
- 3. Holy Water fonts will remain empty. Please use Holy Water dispenser.
- 4. The exchange of the sign of peace is allowed but it must be among the family members. Please use non-contact gesture (bow or wave hand) among other parishioners.

I am so grateful for your cooperation with the Covid-19 measures at our parish for the past fifteen months, especially the wearing of masks. I understand that wearing a mask is difficult and I don't like it myself, but it's an act of charity and for the safety of those around us. Please continue to pray that one day in the near future that all of these restrictions will be removed. I also pray that more of our parishioners will be returning to church in person, even if in a gradual manner, to a normalcy that we had prior to the pandemic, especially now with the lifting of the restrictions and more are receiving their vaccinations.


