# All Souls Day



Dear Friends in Christ,

Starting on Wednesday this week, we are entering into the month of November and on the first two days of November each year, the Church commemorates two feast days: All Saints (Nov. 1, a holy day of obligation) and All Souls (Nov. 2).

On All Saints we remember all those who lived heroic holiness and are in heaven (whether the Church has canonized them or not). On All Souls we pray for all those who have died, manifesting the communion of the Church on earth with the Church suffering in purgatory, and the Church triumphant in heaven. The Catholic tradition of praying for the dead is the first and foremost a sign of our hope in the resurrection and, secondarily, a reminder of the saving grace of purgatory, the opportunity after death to be purified of all our faults and weaknesses not worthy of eternal damnation.

There is a "Roll of Remembrance" paper available in the sanctuary for you to write down the names of your deceased loved ones, friends or someone you knew who died recently. Note that we automatically include the names of those from our parish who have died this past year. In addition, we have envelopes in the back of the church for you to write down names of those who have died that you want to pray for them. Please fill out their names and place the envelope in the Offertory basket or bring it to the parish office. These envelopes then will be placed on the altar so that we remember them at Masses during the month of November.

Blessed are those who have died in the Lord; let them rest from their labors for their good deeds go with them. Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord.

R: And let perpetual light shine upon them.

May their souls and all the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen






On Sunday, October 29, the Confirmation Candidates made their official commitment to enter the preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation
